White Wines, Blush and Bubbles!

Chenin Blanc “Demi –Sec” . 08 Michel Picard. Vouvray, France..... \$8/\$32

Fresh and fruity, this is a medium sweet wine. Palate is round and dominated by crystalized fruit flavors with a very good length.

Riesling. 09 St. Christopher “Spatlese” Piesporter. Mosel, Germany. \$8.50/\$29

This Spatlese has a floral aroma, with a nice mouth feel, and unbelievably balanced! Our most popular Riesling ever!

Pinot Grigio 09. Sycamore Lane. California. \$7 Glass Only.

Sweet aromas of Pear, Melon and Tropical Fruits are accented with a pleasant floral note!

Pinot Grigio 09. Maso Canali. Trentino, Italy. \$8.50/\$34

The nose delivers peach and a hint of honey, and the wine is characterized by enticing flavors of lemon and fresh apple, with floral notes.

Sauvignon Blanc. 09 Whitehaven. Marlborough, New Zealand. \$8.75/\$35

A full flavored, medium bodied wine, with an abundance of archetypal currant and gooseberry flavors, that linger on the dry, clean finish.

White Bordeaux. 09 Chateau Bonnet. Bordeaux, France. \$8.25/\$29

The attack is a lovely balance between the opulence of Sémillion with the crisp quality of the Sauvignon Blanc, combining notes of white peach, blossom and fresh apricot. The addition of Muscadelle lends body and charm, with its exotic, slightly spicy notes contributing to a lingering finish.

Chardonnay. 08 Artesa Napa Valley, CA \$8.50/\$35

Citrus notes of orange, lemon are followed by hints of thyme & a finish of caramel & custard.

Chardonnay. 08. Sonoma Cutrer. Russian River Ranches, CA. \$10 Glass Only.

Aromas of ginger and lemon zest are joined by toasty coconut, melon and caramel alongside a mineral, flinty cedar chest oaky-ness overlaid by notes of honeysuckle.

Chardonnay. 07 Hess Su’Skol Vineyard, Napa Valley, CA. \$11/\$43 bottle.

Asian pear and honeysuckle aromas with Clementine tangerine on the palate. The wine manages to capture the fruit in an impressive choreography of pleasing acidity and subtle oak by aging it for nine months in 20% new French oak barrels.

White Zinfandel. 06 Burlwood. California. \$6.25 Glass only.

Strawberry, raspberry, etc... Good training wheel blush when you are tired of Riesling!

Prosecco. N.V. Canella. Italy. (.187 bottle)..... \$8

Fruity aromas of peach, apple, pear and citrus fruit, the palate gracefully balances zingy acidity and a subtle hint of sweetness, richness and silky-smooth texture.

Sparkling Wine. N.V. Gruet Brut “Rose”. New Mexico. (.375 bottle) \$24 bottle.

Has a lovely, bright floral bouquet with hints of strawberry, raspberry, and cherry.

Red Wines by the Glass.

Pinot Noir. 09 Bridlewood Estate. California. \$8.25/\$30 bottle.

Sweet cherry and tangy current notes lead the palate to flavors of berries, pomegranates and mushrooms. Smoky oak and spice combine with elegant tannins to stretch the mid palate, ending in a luscious finish!

Pinot Noir. 08 Louis Latour. “Valmoissine” Verdon, France. \$9/\$36 bottle.

This Valmoissine has an intense color and developed aromas of candied fruit. In the mouth the fruit is supple. Silky smooth finish.

Pinot Noir. 08 Chateau Bianca. Willamette Valley, OR. \$9/\$36 bottle.

Strong red fruit characteristics in both flavor and aroma. Raspberry, cranberry, red cherry and even blueberry. This is a light to medium bodied wine for your enjoyment!

Malbec. 08 Ruta 22 Patagonia, Argentina. \$8.50/\$33 bottle.

Flavors of blackberries and blueberries with a hint of plum. Smooth and round in the mouth with firm but approachable tannins!

Petite Sirah. 08 Spellbound. Lodi, CA. \$8.25/\$30 bottle.

Undertones of vanilla crème brûlée, while softening the tannins and enhancing the structure.

Red Blend. 08 Antu “Ninquen” Cabernet Sauvignon/Carmenere. Chile. \$8.50/\$33

Focused on a rich, vibrant core of ripe blackberry, plums and spice. Balanced and deep, well structured too.

Red Blend. 08 Decoy by Duckhorn Vineyards. Napa Valley, CA. \$11/\$40 bottle.

Enticing aromatics, sweet red fruit, supple tannins and firm, integrated oak. Beginning with aromas of raspberry, cherry pie, spice and cedar, the blend showcases an array of elements, from flavorful layers of cranberry, red currant and cassis to more nuanced hints of orange peel, amaretto and coffee.

Shiraz. 08 Nine Stones. Barossa Valley, Australia. \$9/\$30 bottle.

Powerful with layers of ripe blackberries, dark cherries and luscious chocolate, mocha and macerated fruit characters.

Zinfandel. 07. Campus Oaks “Old Vine” Lodi, CA. \$8/\$28 bottle.

Sourced from four blocks of vineyards, which average 90 years of age, this Zinfandel delivers a great nose, wonderful mouth-feel, good legs and a silky-smooth finish.

Zinfandel. 07. Earthquake. Lodi, CA. \$10/\$42 bottle.

Huge, dark and rich. Coffee, dark chocolate, blackberry, plum and black cherry aromas, with smoky, spicy notes. Powerfully rich in the mouth with good intensity. A long spicy finish.

Merlot. 07. 14 Hands. Washington State. \$8/\$28 bottle.

Ripe fruit flavors are joined by subtle toast and mocha nuances. While soft and approachable, this wine maintains a sturdy frame of tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon. 08 14 Hands. Washington State. \$8/\$28 bottle.
Classic aromas of dark stone fruits and toast. Flavors of cherries and spice are accentuated by fine, round tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon. 07 Louis Martini Napa Valley, CA. \$9.50/\$41 bottle.
Intense aromas of ripe cherry, cassis, and pipe tobacco. Concentrated flavors of ripe plums, and dark bing cherries marry perfectly with the oak nuances.

Cabernet Sauvignon. 07 Merryvale. Napa Valley. \$11/\$45 bottle.
Enticing aromas of black cherry, cassis, raspberry, vanilla and cedar. The mouth feel is dense and focused with a long finish.

Dessert Wines and Ports

Dornfelder. 08 Stein 1 Sweet Red Wine. Germany. \$7.75 (Glass Only)
Easy approaching, non oaked fruity red wine with flavors of cherries and blackberry.

Port. Penfold's "Club Port". Australia \$8 (Glass Only)
A blend of vintages - oak matured at Penfolds' Kalimna cellars, in the Barossa Valley.

Port. Trevor Jones. "Jonesy". Australia. \$8 (Glass Only)
Its light to medium ruby hue is accompanied by an extraordinary bouquet of sweet candied fruit intermixed with notions of maple syrup, earth, and hazelnuts.

Porto. Kopke. Fine Ruby N.V. Portugal. \$8 (Glass Only)
Kopke Ruby ages in oak casks. With a ruby color, it reveals a fruity and young bouquet.

Porto. Graham's "Six Grapes" Portugal. \$9 (Glass Only)
The "everyday" Port for the Vintage Port drinker. Six Grapes is bottled relatively young (between 3 and 4 years) in order to retain the freshness and vigour comparable to a young Vintage Port.

Porto. Graham's 10 Year Old. Portugal. \$11 (Glass only)
Deep amber color, complex orange peel and marzipan aromas. Flavorful rich fruitcake spiciness with hints of walnut's, beautifully mellowed with an elegant, long finish.
